The Art of the Brick Traveling Exhibition

Through August 18, Perot Museum of Nature and Science

Named by CNN as a must-see exhibition, *The Art of the Brick* makes its Texas debut featuring LEGO brick renditions of famous masterpieces – including Van Gogh's *Starry Night*, Michelangelo's *David* along with a 20-foot T. rex skeleton and Dallas' iconic Pegasus – plus, *The Science of the Brick* interactive creative space. The critically acclaimed exhibition touts the largest and most elaborate display of works constructed using only LEGO bricks.



Created by internationally renowned contemporary artist Nathan Sawaya, *The Art of the Brick* is designed to inspire ingenuity and creativity with original pieces and re-imagined versions of some of history's most famous works of art. North Texans will get the first glimpse of Sawaya's newest sculpture created specifically for the Perot Museum exhibition - an original interpretation of Dallas' signature winged horse, Pegasus, constructed solely from LEGO bricks which will greet guests as they enter the Museum. Visitors can use their powers of estimation to guess the number of LEGO bricks used in the Pegasus sculpture for a chance to win a year-long Perot Museum Premium Family membership.

Visitors can also get up-close with fan favorite *Yellow*, a life-size sculpture of a man ripping his chest open with thousands of yellow LEGO bricks cascading from the cavity. The exhibition also offers a gallery showcasing an innovative, multimedia collection of LEGO-brick infused photography produced in tandem with award-winning photographer Dean West.

HOURS: General hours of operation for the Perot Museum are 10am-5pm, Monday through Saturday and 11am-5pm, Sunday. From May 24-Sept. 2, the Perot Museum will be open 10am-6pm, Monday-Saturday and 11am-6pm, Sunday. Member-only hours are from 9-10am every Saturday and 10-11am every Sunday during which members can enjoy exclusive access to the Perot Museum.

Children under 2 are always free. *The Art of the Brick* requires a surcharge of \$10 for adults (13-64) and seniors (65+), \$8 for youth (2-12) and is free for children under 2. The Texas Rangers 2019 season is almost here! Discounted tickets range from \$3-\$18 off of the regular price and depend on your game date selection, seating preference, and availability. This year, the discount will apply to all games except Opening Day and the last two home games of the season (September 28 and 29). **Contact your concierge for a calendar with pricing chart for this year as well as a parking map and schedule of promotional game dates.** There are two price-points: All Star games and Hall of Fame games.



VERY IMPORTANT INFORMATION: A few years ago the Rangers implemented a dynamic price structure. The same remains true this year. This means there is a base price for every area, and then – based on supply and demand of any given game – the price of tickets could go up (if the demand is higher). They're still discounted from regular prices, and it is unlikely that the fluctuations will be too dramatic. They analyze their inventory for future games probably once a month and then make any changes they deem necessary. This also means that if you order tickets for a game one day, and then want to add tickets to that same game later, the price could theoretically be different at that time. You may purchase tickets in other seating areas besides those listed below but a discount would not apply.
